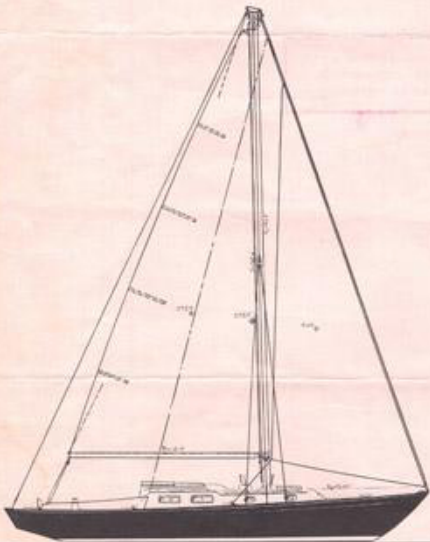

Among these are the exceptional amount of room below decks. . . from 6'-0" headroom in forward stateroom to 6'-4" in main cabin, 6'-4" berths (main cabin), 6'-5" berths (forward cabin), extra large washroom with toilet, wash basin and linen locker; wide selection of interior colors with judicious use of teak and mahogany to add warmth to yacht's appearance; many large lockers for stowage of gear, sails, oilskins, etc.; dressers in both cabins; 6 berths standard; well equipped galley; masthead rig; 30 HP Atomic 4 engine; and many other features that reflect the thoroughness of the master designer whose name it proudly wears.
